A Word of Explanation

Through the years, many changes have occurred in the process of becoming a United Methodist Minister, in part to accommodate the different kinds of ministry into which one is called, various journeys of Christian faith and diverse stages of life. As accommodating as these changes have been, they may be confusing. Hence, the following brief explanation of parts of tonight's service.

CLERGY CONFERENCE MEMBERSHIP/ CLERGY ORDERS

Although often tied together, clergy conference membership and clergy orders are actually distinct from each other.

- Orders relate to God's call to ministry
- **Conference membership** relates to fulfilling that call within the United Methodist Church.

ELDER/DEACON

- **Deacons** are ordained to a "lifetime ministry of Word and Service to both the community and the congregation..." (Par.329.1)
- Elders are ordained to a "lifetime ministry of Service, Word, Sacrament and Order." (Par.332)

PROVISIONAL COMMISSIONING

Commissioning denoted progress toward, but not completion of, the requirements for ordination, a
commitment to ministry and intention to enter full conference membership. Therefore, commissioned
clergy are Provisional Members.
