Why do parents need to attend?

Communication between parents and children is essential; especially when dealing with matters of human sexuality. In order for parents to know and understand the content of the sessions and affirm their child's participation in *Created by God*, at least one parent needs to attend the Thursday evening parent session and Saturday afternoon closing celebration.

At the parent meeting which is held prior to the *Created by God* weekend, the leader will give a Biblical, theological and statistical rationale for human sexuality education in a Christian Education setting. Also, he/she will tell parents exactly what will be presented to the students during the course of the weekend and demonstrate the methods and materials that will be used. Of course, all questions and concerns of the parents will be addressed during this time.

Why can't my child miss a couple of hours on Saturday morning?

In order for the students to establish a comfort level with the group and the subject matter, the program is deigned in such a way as to progressively build a community of trust through a variety of activities. Also, by attending all sessions in their entirety, students will receive complete, rather than piecemeal information.

How are leaders certified in CBG?

All certified *CBG* leaders are Safe Sanctuary approved meaning they have gone through an application and interview process, reference checks, a criminal background check, and an Arkansas Child Maltreatment check. After completing the set number of hours required for observing and leading a *Created by God* class and submitting a set of lesson plans, the applicant is then approved by the Arkansas Conference Council on Children's Ministries. Currently, all of the CBG certified leaders are or have been public school teachers and/or administrators.

How much does this cost?

You will negotiate a contract with your *Created by God* leader. Typically, this includes payment for 8 hours of preparation and parent/student contact time plus mileage and/or lodging. Each student will need a book (about \$7), a few miscellaneous craft supplies, snacks and lunch on Saturday.
