The Susanna Wesley Award is presented to the unit which demonstrates the most distinctive "faith in action" activity as a direct result of a Mission Study. This award is to recognize a Unit that goes over and above our usual collections of items and/or money. The largest units to the smallest units can all apply for this award. Each application is judged by the size of the unit and the actions taken by that unit. Comparisons will not be made with other applications received that year.

As a wife and mother in a small 18th century English parish, Susanna Wesley herself received little recognition for how she managed her household, raised and educated more than a dozen children and coped with a sometimes impecunious, idealistic and occasionally difficult clergyman husband. Yet from her personal influence and loving home care, a son who would experience a spiritual awakening and use that inspiration to begin a ministry that would fill a void in the national spiritual life and also develop into a world wide church. Indeed, it might be said that the movement called Methodism had its foundations in the home of Susanna Wesley.

The Susanna Wesley Award is so named in honor of this strong, intelligent and spiritually mature woman.

- ◆ Fill in the form below and submit it to your District Education and Interpretation Mission Coordinator by August 15.

- ◆ The award will be presented at the Conference Annual Meeting in November.
- ◆ This award is not necessarily awarded each year. If no unit qualifies in a particular year, the award will not be given.
