
## Evangelical United Brethren Bishops of Arkansas • 1885 - 1968


The United Brethren Conference that included Northern Arkansas and Southern Missouri was called the Southern Missouri Conference from 1885-1893 No United Brethren Conference included Arkansas within its territory between 1893 and 1918.

The United Brethren Conference that included Arkansas and Oklahoma was called the Oklahoma Conference from 1919-1923 The United Brethren Conference that included Arkansas, Missouri and Louisiana was called the Missouri Conference from 1929-1946 The United Brethren and the Evangelical Association merged in 1946 to form the Evangelical United Brethren.

The Evangelical United Brethren conference that included Arkansas, Missouri and Couisiana was called the Missouri Conference from 1946 to 1968. In 1968 the Evangelical United Brethren Church merged with The Methodist Church to form the new denomination: The United Methodist Church.









No Bishop was assigned in the years 1885-1886, 1889, and 1893-1917.




