They create their own reality and worldview from their own experiences.



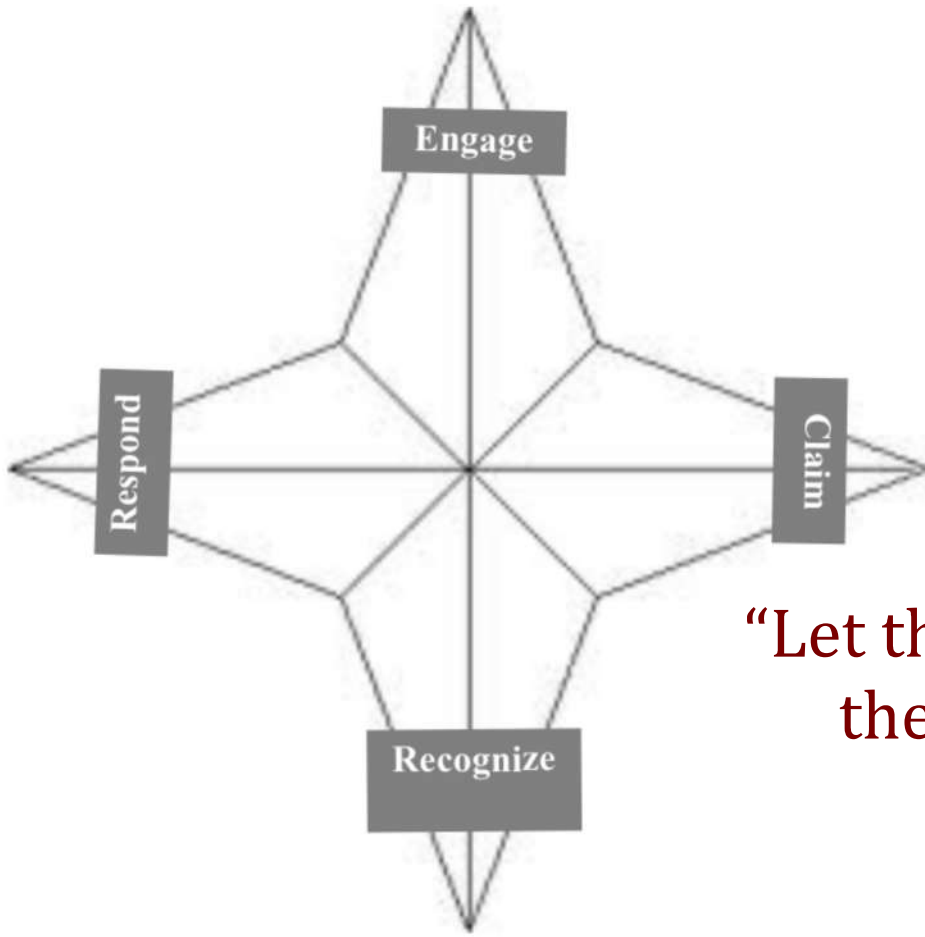
