## 1 Samuel

- Hannah asks God for a child
- Samuel listens to God
- Samuel anoints David
- David & Goliath



*"Man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart."*

## 2 Samuel

- David becomes king
- God's promise to David
- Solomon is born



*"The LORD gave David victory wherever he went."*

*2 Samuel 8:6*



## 1 Kings

- Solomon asks for wisdom
- Solomon builds the temple
- Elijah & his miracles



*"O LORD, God of Israel, there is no God like you in heaven above or on earth below."*

*1 Kings 8:23*



## 2 Kings

- Elijah taken up to heaven
- Elisha & his miracles
- Josiah finds God's Word



*"[Josiah] did what was right in the eyes of the LORD."*

*2 Kings 22:2*



# 1 Chronicles

- A retelling of Israel's history, including David becoming king and his plans to build the temple.



HISTORY

*"Yours, O LORD, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all."*

1 Chronicles 29:11



# 2 Chronicles

- A continued retelling of Israel's history, including Solomon building the temple and Josiah finding the book of the law.



HISTORY

*"As long as [Josiah] lived, they did not fail to follow the LORD, the God of their fathers."*

2 Chronicles 34:33



# Ezra

- Completion of the temple
- People return from exile



HISTORY

*"Though we are slaves, our God has not deserted us in our bondage."*

Ezra 9:9



# Nehemiah

- Rebuilding Jerusalem's walls
- Israelites return to Jerusalem
- Israelites dedicate themselves to God



HISTORY

*"We will not neglect the house of our God."*

Nehemiah 10:39



# Esther

- Esther is made queen
- Esther saves God's people



HISTORY

*"Who knows but that you have come to royal position for such a time as this?"*

Esther 4:14



# Job

- Job loses his flocks & family
- Job remains faithful
- Job's treasures are restored



*"Shall we accept good from God, and not trouble?"*

Job 2:10



# Psalms

- Songs of praise & thanks
- Prayers for God's help



*"The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want."*  
Psalm 23:1



# Proverbs

- Wise teachings from Solomon about life, our relationships with others and with God



*"The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge."*  
Proverbs 1:7



# Ecclesiastes

- Wisdom from Solomon about God's ultimate power and perfect control over the world and us



*"There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven."*  
Ecclesiastes 3:1



# Song of Solomon

- Solomon's love song



*"Place me like a seal over your heart . . . for love is as strong as death."*  
Song of Solomon 8:6



# Isaiah

- Isaiah tells about the Messiah
- Isaiah corrects & encourages God's people



*"Those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles."*  
Isaiah 40:31



# Jeremiah

- Jeremiah warns against sin
- Jeremiah tells about Jesus' coming



*"For I know the plans I have for you, . . . plans to give you hope and a future."*  
Jeremiah 29:11

# Lamentations

- God's people express sorrow for their sins

*"The LORD is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him."*  
Lamentations 3:25

# Ezekiel

- Ezekiel sees visions from God
- Ezekiel warns the people to obey
- Ezekiel predicts the coming Messiah

*"My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and they will be my people."*  
Ezekiel 37:27

# Daniel

- The fiery furnace
- Daniel in the lions' den
- Daniel explains the king's dreams

*"Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God."*

# Hosea

- Hosea warns God's people of punishment
- Hosea promises God's blessings for obedience

*"The ways of the LORD are right; the righteous walk in them, but the rebellious stumble in them."*

# Joel

- Joel calls people to obey God
- Joel predicts signs of the end times

*"But the LORD will be a refuge for his people."*

## Obadiah

- Obadiah sees a vision from God about the sins of the world

*"The day of the LORD is near for all nations. As you have done, it will be done to you."*  
Obadiah 15



## Jonah

- Jonah swallowed by fish for his disobedience to God
- Jonah obeys & goes to Nineveh

*"Salvation comes from the LORD."*  
Jonah 2:9



## Micah

- Micah tells that the Messiah will be born in Bethlehem
- Micah warns against the sins of the people

*"What does the LORD require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God."*

Micah 6:8



## Nahum

- Nahum warns of God's anger toward the people of Nineveh

*"The LORD is a jealous and avenging God."*

Nahum 1:2



## Habakkuk

- Habakkuk complains to God about evil people, and God promises to punish their sins

*"I will rejoice in the LORD, I will be joyful in God my Savior."*  
Habakkuk 3:18



## Zephaniah

- Zephaniah teaches about the end times and God's punishment of our sins

*"The great day of the LORD is near—near and coming quickly."*

Zephaniah 1:14

## Haggai

- Haggai encourages God's people to finish building His temple

## Zechariah

- Zechariah sees unusual visions from God calling His people to return to Him

PROPHECY

*"Return to me," declares the  
LORD Almighty, "and I will  
return to you."*

*Zechariah 1:3*

- Malachi reminds people to be faithful to God because God is faithful to us

PROPHECY

*"I the LORD do not change."*

*Malachi 3:6*
