

## Elizabeth Thornburg Workman Fund (ETW Fund)

During World War II a fund-raising effort was begun among Methodist Women's groups in Arkansas to help support missionaries, inform young people of the challenge of missionary service, and strengthen the bond between college students and the church. Named in honor of Elizabeth Thornburg Workman, past president of the conference and wife of the president of Henderson Brown College (now Henderson State University). Today the ETW provides scholarships for many children and youth to attend the Arkansas Conference Mission u each summer. Scholarships are awarded based on criteria such as ethnic diversity, financial need and first time attendance. When funds are available scholarships are also awarded to adults. Every United Methodist Women Local Unit is encouraged to contribute at least \$1.00 per member annually to the ETW Fund.
